Official information request for information regarding the meaning of the Crown Our Ref: OIA353/1

1. I refer to your request dated 14 June 2023 under the Official Information Act 1982 for information relating to the Crown and Treaty settlements.

- 2. To the extent your questions are in the nature of a request for legal advice, we are unable to answer them. Crown Law's role is to provide legal advice and representation to the New Zealand Government, and it cannot provide legal advice to anyone else, including private individuals. With that constraint in mind, we have responded to your request for information as far as we can.
- 3. In relation to your first inquiry, it is the same Crown that has entered into and signed all Treaty settlements in New Zealand with Māori, whether or not the Crown is styled (or referred to) as "Her Majesty the Queen in Right of New Zealand" or simply "the Crown". We add that we have no knowledge of Her Majesty the Queen in Right of New Zealand being a registered company under the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission.
